### **Rudd Government delivers \$263,000 for three community projects on the West Coast**

THREE substantial community projects can now begin on the West Coast after the Rudd Government this week signed off on \$263,000 to the West Coast Council, Federal Member for Braddon Sid Sidebottom said.

The funding comes under the \$800 million Regional and Local Community Infrastructure Program to support jobs and boost local economies by building and renewing community infrastructure.

The West Coast Council will receive \$263,000 funding for the following projects:

- \$12,000 to refurbish the Queenstown Tennis Court
- \$191,000 to upgrade Howards Park at Zeehan
- \$60,000 to build a skate park at Rosebery

"I am thrilled that this funding will go to these very worthwhile projects," Mr Sidebottom said.

"New nets and posts can now be purchased for the Queenstown Tennis Court, while fencing and seating can now also be replaced.

"A new undercover BBQ area with facilities will now be built at Howards Park, with a skate park, seating and fencing also to be constructed.

"Stage One of a skate park at Rosebery, including a concrete slab, fencing, lighting and some ramps will also be completed.

"These projects will not only support construction jobs in the local area, but will add to the attractiveness of these communities – this benefits locals and visitors alike."

Mr Sidebottom said the West Coast Council would receive a contract soon.
